"Doing a portrait is always an interesting challenge, because it is not just a face, it's the whole person and oftentimes his/her world we are dealing with: How this person feels, their history, their likes, their dreams, and especially their humor. And the treatment and styling will try to resonate with all that, so we are not adapting the person to a given style but just the opposite. For instance, someone who is a fan of Marvel Comics, or Italian Renaissance painters or surrealist or cubic painting, or graphite drawings or woodcuts, we can render the portrait in any of those styles and more."
